## Ventenna<sup>tm</sup> Attic Mounting Kit

The Ventenna can be mounted in an attic using the mounting bracket included with this kit. Mounting takes less than five minutes. Follow the instructions below, and refer to the photographs.

- 1. Select a location away from pipes, wiring or foil-backed insulation, and place the Ventenna in position for a pre-installation test. Verify that the SWR is within acceptable limits.
- 2. Nail the Attic Mounting bracket to a rafter at the chosen location.
- 3. Remove the mounting screws from the Ventenna. Look into the bottom of the Ventenna to see where the cable is located.
- 4. Orient the Ventenna so that the cable is inside the 'U' of the mounting bracket. Press the Ventenna over the bracket. It is a tight fit and you may have to squeeze the sides of the bracket together slightly to push the Ventenna all the way down. Be careful not to pinch or scrape the coaxial cable.
- 5. Connect the feedline and you are done!
